to effect positive change.







General Expectations - Camp Rules-

- Actively participate in all scheduled activities.
- Show respect to everyone, including campers and staff.
- 3 Illegal drugs and alcohol at the camp is strictly prohibited.
- 4 Communicate openly with Camp Counselors or the Admin Team to resolve any issues.
- 5 Avoid behavior that endangers yourself or others.
- 6 Be mindful of your actions and their impact on others.
- Listen to instructions and express your opinions respectfully.
- 8 Keep personal belongings safe and secure.
- 9 Report emergencies or situations that may endanger anyone in the group.
- 10 Follow designated quiet hours and sleeping times in the cabins.



- Stay on designated paths and areas within the camp venue.
- 12 Fulfill assigned chores or responsibilities to maintain cleanliness.
- Refrain from bullying, harassment, or discrimination.
- 14 Adhere to the camp's dress code guidelines.
- 15 Obtain permission before leaving the camp venue or participating in off-site activities.
- 16 Refrain from using mobile phones or electronic devices during scheduled camp activities, workshops, and group sessions. Devices may be used during designated break times or free periods.
- Use recreational equipment responsibly and follow safety guidelines.
- 18 Respect wildlife and the natural environment, avoid littering or damaging vegetation.
- 19 Additional rules may be added during the camp that are not listed.
